- Dental implants are considered the 'gold standard' for tooth replacement.

What is a Dental Implant?

A dental implant is a means by which we can provide a long term solution for filling a gap due to a lost tooth or teeth.

The implant replaces the natural tooth root and we then place a crown or bridge onto the implant. This provides you with a restoration that will look and feel similar to natural teeth.

Why would I need an implant?

Implants may be used for a variety of different reasons:

- Missing one tooth: You may have lost a tooth or have a failing tooth which needs replacing.
- Missing multiple teeth: You may have numerous missing teeth which need replacing, this can often be done by using implants to support dental bridges.
- To retain dentures: Implants can be used to secure dentures in place.
- A full mouth reconstruction: you may have multiple failing teeth and need to replace all of the teeth in one jaw or both.

Advantages of Dental Implants:

- **Smile with confidence** - we aim to provide you with dental implants that appear natural and give a great cosmetic look.
- **Improved function** - we often find our patients are able to laugh, talk and eat with much more confidence. Back to the foods you love!
- **Improved oral hygiene** - dental implants need regular brushing, flossing and dental hygiene appointments - just like your own teeth.
- **Less invasive to neighbouring teeth** - by replacing lost teeth with an implant, no support is required from adjacent teeth. This means that your natural teeth do not need to be altered or damaged in any way.
- **Reduced bone loss** - when we lose teeth, the bone which held that tooth begins to disappear. If a dental implant is put into the bone it can stimulate bone growth and production, thus preventing loss of our valuable bone structure in the jaw.

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Risks of Dental Implants:

On occasion implants can fail, the risk of failure is approximately 1%-5% depending on specific circumstances. At Horbury Dental Care we have a low failure rate of 2%. If an implant fails it can generally be replaced, occasionally additional procedures may be required.

There is also a risk of accidental damage to adjacent anatomic structures such as teeth, though with accurate planning this should be avoidable.

There is a low risk of failure of implants after the first years in function as long as your health, both general and around the implant is maintained and no excessive forces are exerted. Excessive forces may result in some of the component parts fracturing. Like natural teeth, implants are subject to wear and tear as time goes on and depending upon the amount of wear, the need to replace the crown may arise. There is a risk of gum recession around the implant and though this may not affect its survival, it may require treatment for aesthetic reasons.

How long do dental implants last?

In a healthy person with a healthy mouth and bone, implants can last a lifetime. Like natural teeth dental implants do require a good oral hygiene routine and regular visits to the dentist for reviews, scale and polishes.

How much will it cost?

As with many treatments in dentistry, it is not always possible to give an exact price for treatment as all cases are different and require individual evaluation.

A detailed clinical assessment is required to ascertain your suitability for dental implant treatment.

During your appointment the dentist will take his time to obtain your full dental history whilst carrying out a detailed clinical examination of your mouth along with any x-rays required.

(Please note: CT scans are not included in the cost of an assessment)
