CASE STUDIES: REFORE & AFTER

Case Study 1

David came to us because his front teeth were very loose and he was concious his front tooth was about to fall out. The idea of dentures at 50 years old was something he did not want to consider. We treated both jaws; we removed all his teeth, placed implants and connected bridgework. He was able to benefit from same day treatment to replace all his failing teeth and at no time did he have to wear a denture.

Case Study 2

Louise is 42 years old with gum disease. She had already lost her back teeth and hated her smile. We treated the gum disease in her lower jaw and successfully kept her lower natural teeth. In the upper jaw, we removed the remaining front teeth, placed a series of implants and placed bridgework. Louise benefitted from "same day" treatment and at no time did she need to wear a denture.

Case Study 3

Sarah is 39 years old and hated her teeth. She had gum disease which led to drifting and movement of the teeth which had become loose and uncomfortable. Sarah hated her appearance so much she felt that she wouldn't go out and socialise. She did not smile and this affected her emotionally and pyschologically.

We removed all her teeth, immediately placed implants and rehabilitated her with bridgework on the same day.

Sarah did not have to wear dentures and could see an immediate improvement in her smile. The benefits to her confidence were immediate! For the first time in years Sarah wanted to go out to socialise and show off her new smile. She told us "you will never know how grateful I am...... you have changed my life!"

ALL ABOUT DENTAL IMPLANTS

WHAT IS A DENTAL IMPLANT?

A long-term solution for filling a gap. Dental Implants look and feel like real teeth. An implant is an anchor, or foundation, which replaces a tooth root in the jaw. They are made of titanium and biologically integrate or fuse to the bone. They are placed at key strategic locations in order to support fixed bridgework.

LET US BREAK DOWN THE IMPLANT PROCESS FOR YOU INTO 4 EASY STEPS:

STFP 1

Planning is crucial and we will take photos, CT scans and digital impressions. We work with our technician to plan treatment carefully and the results are discussed with you to gain your approval.

STEP 2

You arrive at the surgery early one morning and will be met with one of our dedicated team. The failing teeth are removed and implants are placed, this is usually carried out under sedation to keep you comfortable. You will rest with us for several hours until the bridge work is made and in the afternoon your new smile will be restored.

STFP 3

Healing is now required for approximately 6 months. When we are happy with progress, a new final bridge is made over several appointments.

STEP 4

Once the desired result has been achieved, we will continue to see you regularly to ensure your gum and bone health is maintained to the highest standard.

Mark Vincent Willings qualified from Guys Hospital in London in 1991 and returned to Wakefield to join the Associate team and work with his father in 1994.

In 1998, Eric and Mark consolidated the practice and moved to the present location in Queen Street, Horbury. These purpose built premises were state of the art and moved the practice into a new era as Mark became a partner in the business.
